

Stocks have continued higher regardless of party holding the presidency


Growth of \$1k since 1926





Last 70 years, \$1,000 invested 12/31/1953, depending on which party held the presidency




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U.S. stocks across the election cycle

Average annual return, 1/1/26 – 12/31/23



Average return, 1/1/26 – 12/31/23



S&P 500 performance, 1/1/00 through 1/13/01






Satisfaction with the direction of the country can be a contrarian indicator of the market

% of Americans satisfied with the way things are going in the U.S.


U.S. stock market returns next 12 months


